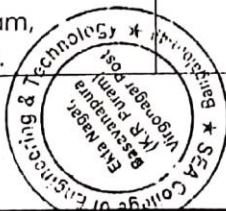



## 11. Admission Procedure

FOR KEA/COMED-KFOR GENERAL MERIT CANDIDATES: A candidate who has Passed in 2nd PUC / 12 Std / Equivalent Examination with English as one of the Language and obtained a Minimum of 45% of Marks in aggregate in Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with Chemistry / Bio Technology / Biology / Computer Science / Electronics as optional subjects in the qualifying examination is eligible to pursue in under graduate programs (BE).

FOR SC/ST & OBC (Cat-I, 2A, 2B, 3A 3B) CATEGORY CANDIDATES: A candidate who has Passed in 2nd PUC / 12 Std / Equivalent Examination with English as one of the Language and obtained a Minimum of 40% of Marks in aggregate in Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with Chemistry / Bio Technology / Biology / Computer Science / Electronics as optional subjects in the qualifying examination is eligible to pursue in under graduate Programs (BE).

The marks obtained by the candidate in Biotechnology/Biology/Computer Science / Electronics in the qualifying examination will be considered in the place of Chemistry in case the marks obtained in Chemistry is less for the required aggregate percentage for the pursue of determination of eligibility.

Entrance Examination: KEA / COMED-K for Management Admissions, Students have to take any one of the Entrance Examination

Through Lateral Entry Scheme Three Years Bachelor of Engineering (B.E. – Lateral Entry Scheme) Programs: A candidate who has passed Qualifying Examination i.e. any diploma examination or equivalent examination and obtained an aggregate minimum of 45 % ( for General Merit Candidates) of marks taken together in all the subjects of the final year (i.e., fifth and six semesters) diploma examination (Q E) is eligible for admission to B E- Courses and 40% of marks in Q. E. in case of SC, ST and Backward Classes of Karnataka Candidates.

ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY FOR FULL TIME TWO YEARS POST GRADUATE PROGRAMS (M. TECH): A candidate with valid GATE score or PG CET of Karnataka A candidate who has passed qualifying examination (i.e., BE/B. Tech Degree) in the relevant discipline and obtained an aggregate minimum of 50% of marks (for General Merit Candidates) taken together in all the subjects of all the years / semesters of the Degree Examination is eligible for admission to ME / M. Tech programs. (45% of marks in qualifying examination in case of SC, ST and Cat-I candidates. (Reservation is applicable only for Karnataka Candidate)

GATE SCHOLARSHIP: For receiving GATE Scholarship, a candidate must have a valid GATE Score Card. Candidate with valid GATE score, opting seats under Sponsored Quota, are not entitled for GATE stipend, SC/ST/OBC candidates with valid GATE Score claiming any other scholarship from Government of Karnataka / India are not entitled for GATE Scholarship. Candidates with valid GATE score opting for seat under Part-Time ME / M. Tech Program are not entitled for GATE stipend.

Two Years Master of Business Administration (MBA) Degree for the academic year 2020-21A candidate who has passed Qualifying Examination i.e., any Recognized Bachelor's Degree of minimum of 3 years duration examination or equivalent examination and obtained an aggregate minimum of 50 % of (for General Merit Candidates) marks taken together in all the subjects including language in all the years of the Degree Examination is eligible for admission to full time MBA course. (45% of marks in Q. E. in case of SC, ST and Category – I of Karnataka Candidates) (Reservation is applicable only for Karnataka Candidates)[Entrance Examination: KMT / CMAT / MAT / PG CET – ANYONE IS MANDATORY]

NOTE: ROUNDING OFF AGGREGATE PERCENT IS NOT PERMITTED.

## Teaching Learning Process

The institution is affiliated with Visvesvaraya Technological University (VTU) and conforms to the norms stipulated in the Continuous Internal Assessment examinations (CIAE) evaluation procedure of VTU as on the prevailing date.

- The norms and regulations governing the evaluation process are conveyed to the students through copies of the syllabus that are delivered to them at the beginning of the first year of their degree course in which they are enrolled.

- The calendar of internal evaluations is prepared by the faculty in advance and communicated to students at the commencement of the semester via the Principal approved the academic calendar of the institute.
  - Students are informed about the internal assessment process by their faculty and through the first-year orientation programme.
  - Students and faculty will be notified of the changes if any in the evaluation procedure by VTU.
  - In ahead of the internal review, the students will be provided with an outline of the portions coverage, question paper pattern concerning their regulations. Questions are asked based on course content and approved by department heads, schemes, faculty before the assessment prepares solutions, and the same is used for evaluation.
  - Evaluation of internal assessment blue books is based on scheme and solutions prepared by the faculty and are given to students at the end of an assessment to verify their marks.
  - Internal assessment for the theoretical subjects is evaluated by:
    1. Three internal tests
    2. Assignments
  - Internal assessment for the practical subjects is evaluated by:
    1. Model exams
  - Internal assessment for the seminars and internship is evaluated by:
    1. Student's presentations and its report, models.
  - The institution publishes the Rules and Regulations for all Programmes as per university norms for the evaluation of Continuous Internal Assessment examinations. In addition to academic rules and regulations, the regulations governing examination, evaluation, and mal-practice etc., are in place

- The institute gathers Feedback from the students on every Internal Assessment (I, II & III) and action shall be taken accordingly for the improvement
